

CHERRY VALLEY POLICE DEPT CRIME ALERT

DATE	DESCRIPTION
08-23-08	A pickup truck was burglarized in the driveway of 104 Franklin St. between 08-22-08 at 7:00pm and 08-23-08 at 7:00am, only a wallet was stolen.
08-23-08	Residential Burglary at 117 North Ulster St. entry was gained via the unlocked Breezeway door. A reciprocating saw was stolen from inside the residence. The attached garage was entered, and the unlocked minivan was gone through. Stolen from the van were a briefcase, cellular phone, and two pairs of sunglasses.
08-25-08	The mailbox at 6734 Hedgewood Rd. was damaged between 8:35am to 9:05am
08-29-08	At 539 Stone Ridge Ln. the residence was the victim of an Attempted Residential Burglary. Resident believes this occurred on 08-27-08 between 1:00am and 3:00am, when they were woke up by their barking dog. On 08-29-08 at about 12:00pm the resident noticed the glass to the basement's sliding glass patio door broken out. Nothing missing.
09-03-08	At 7203 Newburg Rd. the residence was the victim of a Residential Burglary. The owner, upon returning home at 11:00am, noticed the door standing open. Upon checking she noticed the copper water pipes had been cut out of the residence.
09-04-08	At 1046 Griggs Rd. the residence was the victim of a Residential Burglary. Between 8:00am and 12:00pm the garage was entered via the side door. Stolen was a power washer and gas can.
09-12-08	The C.V. School, 619 East State St., about 8:29pm, our Department took a suspicious incident call. The school custodian called stating, while cleaning the school, some unknown person was standing outside the windows whistling at her.

TIPS for KEEPING SAFE: Please remember to remove all valuable personal items from your vehicles, while they are parked in your driveway or on the street. People that are going to break into your vehicle are less likely to do so if they do not see valuables.

Another point to touch on is to remember to lock your house doors, and garage doors at night. During several of the above listed Residential Burglaries, the method of entry was through the unlocked house door. Also our Officers are locating an alarming amount of garage doors being left open all night. Please remember to close and lock all doors to your residence and garages.

Did You Know? The following two Village Ordinances pertain to all property zoned residential.

Sec. 70-72. Parking of trailers on private property.

It shall be unlawful for any party or entity to cause or permit more than one licensed or unlicensed non-motorized vehicle, camping trailer, travel trailer, boat trailer or any other type of trailer on any portion of the property zoned residential. Each day that a violation occurs of this section shall be considered a separate violation.

Sec. 70-33. Parking in residential areas.

No individual or entity shall park any motor vehicle, non-motorized vehicle, camping trailer, travel trailer, boat trailer or any other type of trailer, whether registered or unregistered, on any portion of the property zoned residential other than on bituminous material, concrete or gravel.
