Jill Miller so moved to adopt the agenda with deleting Cherry Valley Fire District Proposed Ordinances. Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion was carried by voice vote.

Jill Miller so moved to approve the September 4, 2007 ordinance committee minutes. Tad Whitchurch seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

RESIDENTIAL LIGHTING ORDINANCE

Jill Miller stated that Attorney Jim Stevens has presented the committee with, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, Chapter 22, Buildings and Building Regulations, Article V Lighting Regulations". **Jill Miller so moved to send this ordinance to the October 2, 2007 village board meeting for first reading, "Chapter 22, Buildings and Building Regulations, Article V Lighting Regulations". Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.**

REGULATIONS AND TOWING OF ABANDONED/INOPERABLE VEHICLES

Jill Miller stated that Attorney Jim Stevens has presented the committee with, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances Chapter 70. Inoperable Vehicles". Attorney Stevens stated that this ordinance deletes Section 70-108 (b) & (c), because this section was under "Snowmobiles" and does not make any references to inoperable vehicles.

Jill Miller so moved to send this ordinance to the village board meeting on October 16th for first reading, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances Chapter 70. Inoperable Vehicles". Tad Whitchurch seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

ADMINISTRATIVE FEES FOR IMPOUNDED VEHICLES

Jill Miller stated that Attorney Jim Stevens has presented the committee with, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, Chapter 70, Article VI, Impoundment of Motor Vehicles (Section 70-120)." It was discussed that the administration fees to be paid to the village is not included in the ordinance. Chief Maitland stated that the impoundment and administrations fees would be reviewed annually. Attorney Stevens recommended not putting an amount in the ordinance. Chief Maitland suggested discussing this further at the next scheduled safety committee meeting. **Jill Miller so moved to send this ordinance to the village board on October 16, 2007 to waive the rules on the first reading and present for passage, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, Chapter 70, Article VI, Impoundment of Motor Vehicles (Section 70-120)". Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.**
