

**ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING
SEPTEMBER 4, 2007**

Chairman Jill Miller called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M.

Jill Miller so moved to adopt the agenda. Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion was carried by voice vote.

Jill Miller so moved to approve the August 6, 2007 ordinance committee minutes. Tad Whitchurch seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

RESIDENTIAL LIGHTING ORDINANCE

David Nord provided the committee with the language to be incorporated into the Outdoor Residential Lighting for standards for R1, R2, R3 & R4 zoning districts. (see attached) It was the consensus that the fine be set at no less than \$50.00 and no more than \$750.00. David Nord said he would research the cost for a light meter reading device. **Tad Whitchurch so moved to authorize Attorney Jim Stevens to draft this into ordinance form. Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.** This will be discussed at the October ordinance committee meeting.

LONG RANGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Attorney Moore presented the committee with "An Ordinance Regarding Capital Improvements from 2006 through 2012." Jill Miller noted that the public works committee recommended having this drafted in ordinance final form. **Jill Miller so moved to send Capital Improvements ordinance to the September 4, 2007 village board meeting for 1st reading. Sally Hollembeak seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.**

DEPOSITING MATERIALS ON THE STREETS

Attorney Moore presented the committee with a draft ordinance, "An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois, Deleting and Reserving Section 58-4 and Modifying Section 58-2 Regarding Depositing Materials on the Streets and Street Obstructions." **Jill Miller so moved to send this ordinance to the September 18, 2007 village board meeting for 1st reading. Tad Whitchurch seconded.** It was recommended to change the fine to not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$750.00 per occurrence. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

REGULATIONS AND TOWING OF ABANDONED/INOPERABLE VEHICLES

Jill Miller noted that everyone received a sample ordinance from the City of Toulon Section 25.8.6. Towing of Inoperable Vehicles from Private Property. Attorney Moore stated that Attorney Stevens had several questions on the different court methods to handling towing abandoned/inoperable vehicles from private property. It was suggested that Chief Maitland and Attorney Stevens review the sample ordinance and to continue discussion at the October ordinance committee meeting.
