

**SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

Linda Melton so moved to adopt the amended agenda: deleting: Postage Meter Agreement. Lori Laye seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

RAPID RESPONSE TEAM TRAINING: Chief Maitland recommended that the board consider allowing Cherry Valley police officers to attend rapid response team training. The cost for the training will be related to overtime for the officers. Sergeant Houde said that he is an instructor for the rapid response team and explained the purpose of the training and why it is important for the Cherry Valley Police Officers to attend the class.

Linda Melton so moved to recommend that the village board approve the amount of \$3,000.00 for the Cherry Valley Police Officers to attend the rapid response team training course. Chief Maitland explained that training had not been in the budget; however, the police department would attempt to absorb the overtime costs in the current budget. Lori Laye seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

2002 DODGE SQUAD CAR: Chief Maitland reported that the 2002 Dodge was to be one of the vehicles to be traded-in for the purchase of the new 2006 police vehicle, but while responding to an emergency call the car blew an engine and now has no trade in value. It was the consensus of the board to pass an ordinance to dispose of the vehicle and place an ad in the Rock River Times for sealed bids.

MONTHLY REPORT: Chief Gary Maitland presented the board with his October 2005 Police Report.
